OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

Ready, Aim, Paintball

If you're looking for a vigorous mental challenge and strategic thinking as well as some physical activity, paintball is North America's fastest-growing action game. Our woods course and speedball field are located near the resort's executive airstrip. All the gear (paint gun, paintballs, mask and protective pullover) is provided. Just bring your sense of adventure and willingness to have fun.

A "Hummer" of a Tour

The Hummer H1 can plow along tilted sideways at a 40-degree angle without rolling over, and can climb up and down a hillside with a 60-degree slope. Those go-anywhere capabilities are showcased on a thrilling ride with a professional driver behind the wheel. Hiking and Biking

AT THE LAKE

With three outdoor pools and a sandy beach, summer guests have every opportunity to swim, stroll or laze the day away on the shores of Peninsula Lake. Plus some boating continues into fall, a great way to get out on the water and enjoy autumn's colours.

Splash Pass

One daily fee gets guests unlimited access to canoes, kayaks, pedal boats, windsurfers, life jackets and our popular Splash Zone inflatable water park on the lake.

Boat Tours

Take a cruise along the bays and inlets of Peninsula and Fairy Lake on our Deerhurst boat, a replica of earlier craft that once ferried travellers around the area.

Waterskiing and Wakeboarding

Show off your skill or learn to ski or wakeboard, the hottest trend on the water. Time for tubing and just soaking up the sun is also cool. Groups can book a one-hour or full-day private session on a top-of-the line wakeboard boat. Prefer to watch? Book a professional **Waterski Show** for your outdoor reception by the lake.

Races and Regattas

Whether it's a leisurely trip, a multi-craft team challenge or a fun-filled rush for the finish line, Deerhurst will organize a watersports event that's just right for your group. Get ready to come aboard, paddle or hoist!

Fishing

Fishing boats, equipment and 4- and 8-hour group charters are all available through Deerhurst. Northern Pike, Bass and lake trout are the most common fish found while spinning, bait casting and flyfishing in the area.



WINTER FUN

When the temperature drops, groups at Deerhurst can head to the Winter Sports Shop and warm up to all kinds of cool outdoor adventures. Nearby spots like Arrowhead Provincial Park, Hidden Valley Highlands Ski Area and Rock Ridge Tubing offer even more white stuff.

Dog sledding

Mush! Hop in and let a team of friendly and enthusiastic Siberian Huskies transport you through an Arctic thrill. Or bring your team to our Dogsledding 101 session to get an up-close glimpse of their incredible abilities, group dynamic and personalities.

Snowmobiling

Explore. Snowmobiling is one of the most popular ways to play in our snow. Deerhurst is located right 2,000 km of groomed local trails as well as the TransOntario Provincial trail system which connects the entire province. Rentals are available nearby.

Cross-Country Skiing

Glide. Approximately 13 km of double-track set trails wind throughout the challenging, wooded terrain that transforms the Deerhurst Highlands golf course into a skier's paradise.

Skating Parties and Games

Speed. As hosts of the Canadian National Pond Hockey Tournament we know a thing or two about rinks. So lace up your own skates or our rentals and get out on the ice for hockey, broomball or pleasure skating.



Downhill Skiing

Slide. With twelve slopes, three quad chairlifts, and a beginner skill handle bar tow, neighbouring Hidden Valley Highlands offers a great day of skiing and snowboarding fun on 35 acres of runs. Most of its terrain is well suited for intermediate and novice skiers and snowboarders, making it a good location for group outings.

Snow Tubing

Fly. Feel like a kid again when you ride a snow tube down our tubing hill at the Lakeside 10th tee. For a fun off-site afternoon or evening, head to nearby Rock Ridge Recreation Park which offers group rates on 6 lighted runs with tows.

Horse-Drawn Hay Rides

Ride. Travel back in time to the era of horsepower as you tour our grounds. It's a great way to socialize or arrive at themed events.

Snowshoeing

Trek. Give new meaning to the words "take a hike" when your group straps on easy-to-use, modern snowshoes for a guided tour or race through the woods.
